JUDGMENT AND ORDER

Cause was called for trial on April 28, 2016. Plaintiff appeared by counsel. Defendant appeared pro se. Plaintiff failed to secure service on Defendant Beechwood Grille, LLC. Therefore, Defendant Beechwood Grille, LLC is hereby dismissed. Evidence was adduced. Cause taken under submission by the Court.

The Court being fully advised in the premises finds as follows:


1. Defendant [REDACTED] entered into a Promissory Note wherein Defendant [REDACTED] agreed to repay to Plaintiff Kuna Meat Co., the amount of \$32,580.02.
2. There is a balance due and owing in the amount of \$9,310.64 on the Promissory Note.
3. The Promissory Note has been owing and due since March 10, 2011.
4. That Plaintiff Kuna Meat Co. is entitled to pre-judgment interest of eighteen percent (18%) per annum from March 21, 2011.
5. That Plaintiff is entitled to reasonable attorney's fees.

Therefore, the Court finds in favor of Plaintiff Kuna Meat Co. and against Defendant [REDACTED]

WHEREFORE, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed that Plaintiff Kuna Meat Co. have and recover from Defendant [REDACTED] as follows:

1. The principal sum of \$9,310.64 (Nine thousand three hundred ten dollars and sixty four cents), plus
2. Said Judgment shall bear pre-judgment interest at the rate of 18% per annum, from
3. March 10, 2011 or \$8,556.11 (Eight thousand five hundred fifty six dollars and eleven cents), plus
4. Attorney's fees in the amount of \$3000.00 (Three thousand dollars and no cents).
5. The total amount of the **Aggregate Judgment** is **\$20,866.75**, (twenty thousand eight hundred sixty six dollars and seventy five cents).
6. Post-judgment is to accrue at the rate of eighteen percent (18%) per annum.
7. Costs are assessed against Defendant [REDACTED]
