ORDER AND JUDGMENT

On April 16, 2019, the State's Motion for Reconsideration of Conditions was called, heard, and subsequently taken under advisement by this Court. After considering the arguments by the State and counsel for the defendant, the Court places the defendant on a personal recognizance bond in the above styled cause.


The conditions of this bond are as follows:

1. The defendant shall have no contact with the victim.
2. The defendant shall have no verbal, written, digital, or any other direct or indirect communication with the victim, the victim's family, or the victim's friends.
3. The defendant shall not speak to, mouth words, wave, gesture, or in any other way interact with the victim, the victim's security camera(s), or the victim's property that the security camera(s) record.
4. The defendant shall not shine, refract, or in any way direct light toward the victim's property or person.
5. The defendant shall immediately delete all WiFi network names that have any reference to the victim including:
 - a. The victim's name (legal spelling or otherwise);
 - b. The victim's address;
 - c. The victim's friends, family, or acquaintances (legal spelling or otherwise);
 - d. Proceedings in this case; or
 - e. Details about the victim or her life not otherwise delineated above.
6. The defendant shall not create, rename, retitle, reproduce, or in any way issue any WiFi network names that have any reference to the victim:
 - a. The victim's name (legal spelling or otherwise);
 - b. The victim's address;

- c. The victim's friends, family, or acquaintances (legal spelling or otherwise);
 - d. Proceedings in this case; or
 - e. Details about the victim or her life not otherwise delineated above.
7. Defendant shall not possess any firearms or ammunition while on bond.
 8. The defendant shall in no way destroy or disturb the personal property of the victim.
 9. The defendant shall not harass, intimidate, threaten, or otherwise interfere with the victim.
 10. The defendant shall refrain from any other acts that create an unreasonable risk to the health, safety, or welfare of the victim.
 11. The defendant shall not in any other way disturb the peace of the victim.

Failure to obey these conditions of bond may subject defendant to bond revocation and/or detention.
