JUDGMENT OF DISMISSAL FOR FAILURE TO PROSECUTE

NOW on this day, the Court, on its own Motion and after reviewing the Court’s file, finds the following:

1. On May 19, 2021, (“Plaintiff”) filed a Petition for Writ of Replevin against Defendant Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners.

2. On June 10, 2021, Defendant’s counsel entered her appearance and filed an Answer.

3. The Court set this matter for a case management conference on September 16, 2021 at 1:30 PM via telephone conference, and the Court mailed a copy of said order to Plaintiff.

4. On September 16, 2021, both Plaintiff and Defendant failed to appear, so this matter was again set for Case Management Conference on November 18, 2021 at 1:30 PM via telephone conference. The Court again mailed a copy of the order to Plaintiff.

5. On November 18, 2021, both Plaintiff and Defendant failed to appear so the matter was set over to February 24, 2022 at 1:30 PM via telephone conference for Case Management Conference, and the Court again mailed a copy of the order to Plaintiff.

6. On February 24, 2022, Plaintiff failed to appear but Defendant's counsel appeared and advised the Court that the matter had been settled and that it was expecting a voluntary dismissal to be filed by Plaintiff.


7. Nevertheless, the Court set this matter over to March 10, 2022 at 1:30 PM via telephone conference for Case Management Conference to give Plaintiff one more chance to appear, and included in the Order that failure to appear could result in dismissal of this matter for want of prosecution. The Court mailed a copy of that Order to Plaintiff.

8. Plaintiff did not appear on March 10, 2022 at 1:30 PM. For all of the foregoing reasons, it is therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the above captioned matter be and the same is hereby dismissed without prejudice at Plaintiff's costs for want of prosecution.
